

ATTENTION ALL MINORS AND PARENTS

REVISED 4/29/11

We have been informed by the insurance carrier that the Minor Waiver and Release form for minor drivers is only valid for one class of race cars. This means that any time you change equipment or divisions you must have a new Minor Waiver and Release form that is signed and notarized. If both parents cannot be there, it must be properly notarized before arriving at the track. If only one parent is living or only one parent has custody of the minor child you will need a written statement as to the circumstances and have it notarized that we can keep on file.

For minor spectators that enter the pit area, a Minor Waiver and Release form that is signed and notarized is required. If both parents cannot be there, it must be properly notarized before arriving at the track. If only one parent is living or only one parent has custody of the minor child you will need a written statement as to the circumstances and have it notarized that we can keep on file. For minor spectators between the ages of 10-13, a designated "cold" pit area, once hot laps have begun till after all races have been completed. While in the designated "hot" pit area before hot laps and after the races, all minors must be within reach of a parent at all times.

We also have to have a copy of their birth certificate. We can keep this on file and you will only need to bring one copy for the season, or you must bring a copy with you each time you come.

Forms may be downloaded from website using a color printer or may be picked up at the track, we will have plenty on hand so you may get enough for the entire season.
